


Yellow warning **Wind**

Between 15:00 Wed 16 Feb 2022 and 06:00 Thu <u>17 Feb 2022</u>



Storm Dudley to bring a spell of very strong winds and a risk of disruption later Wednesday and into the small hours of Thursday

What to expect

- Road, rail, air and ferry services may be affected, with longer journey times and cancellations possible, as well as some roads and bridges may close
- Fallen trees and some damage to buildings, such as tiles blown from roofs, could happen
- Power cuts may occur, with the potential to affect other services, such as mobile phone coverage
- There is a chance of injuries and danger to life from flying debris, as well as large waves and beach material being thrown onto sea fronts, coastal roads and properties

Further details

After a windy day, westerly winds are expected to increase further later on Wednesday afternoon and evening across southern Scotland, Northern Ireland, northern England, then parts of Wales, the Midlands and East Anglia.

There is still some uncertainty in the timing and location of the strongest winds but there is the potential for inland wind gusts of 60-70 mph in places. Gusts of 80-90 mph are possible around exposed coasts of southwest Scotland for a brief time.

The worst of the winds will ease through Thursday morning, though remaining generally windy during the day.
